Johannesburg - Thursday, 14 February 2019 – The South African Broadcasting Corporation (SABC) would like to announce the launch of its business programme called Economics Unbound. The weekly Current Affairs show is set to air weekly, starting tonight Thursday, 14 February 2019.

Economics Unbound is one of the flagship programmes of the SABC News Division since its repositioning in June 2018. The show seeks to rise above the market noise that obscures the understanding of the economy, how it operates and how it is managed. The show seeks to include ordinary South Africans in purposeful and well informed discussions about the economy, while providing them with enough information to make better economic and financial decisions. Through this programme, which is anchored by SABC News' erudite Economics Editor, Thandeka Gqubule-Mbeki and a widget named Nana, audiences can look forward to 30 minutes of deep and tough questioning on the issues of the week, including interviews with key decision makers and experts.
