



SABC TELEVISION LICENSING EXPLOITATION FEE PAYMENTS

Process Holder: SABC Television Business Development

The process that the SABC follows with regards to the payment of exploitation fees is as follows:

1. On a bi-annual basis the SABC posts a list of all programmes that have been licensed during the previous six-month period on the SABC Content Commissioning website. Encore is an exception as those programmes are listed on an annual basis following the release of the audited financial results.
2. On the basis of those lists Producers and Lead actors are requested to contact the SABC in order to verify the outstanding amounts owed to them.
3. Upon receipt of the information and referencing their artist number they should issue an invoice for the amount agreed to. This will be 15% for producers, 10% for writers and two percent collectively for lead actors. The producers claim on behalf of the writers.
4. Exploitation fee payment is triggered by receipt of payment from the licensee to the SABC.
5. Payment will be made on basis of the submitted invoices.
