### **QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

For an entity that is not 51% black-owned but has a black empowerment partner with whom a joint venture has been entered, would the proposal meet the prequalification criteria? And if so, what documents would be required?

The black ownership component and the B-BBEE Status Level as whole is subject to verification by a dedicated division within the SCM department that reviews compliance to the prequalification criteria based on the predetermined documents as outlined in the bid document and other applicable SCM Prescripts for a Joint Venture, Partnership and Consortium. JVs, Partnerships and Consortiums are therefore encouraged to submit a proposal provided one of the B-BBEE requirements stated in the Prequalification Criteria are met.
